The area of **Auronzo Misurina, Lozzo, Vigo**It is located between the Northern Dolomites and the Oltrepiave Dolomites. **Three Peaks of Lavaredo** represent the symbol of the Dolomites in the world and Auronzo is the only one **urban center** from which they are visible, on their side facing south.

During your walk you will notice the beautiful houses of the village, with a unique architectural style that reflects the history and culture of the area. These wooden and stone houses, with simple and linear shapes, were built according to the principles of the traditional architecture of the Dolomites, with the utmost attention to detail and respect for the surrounding environment. The emotions you feel while walking along the narrow streets of the center of Auronzo are many. First of all, the beauty of the surrounding landscape leaves you speechless: the majestic mountains that stand out on the horizon and the peace and tranquility that you breathe, the calm and serenity that pervade every corner. Thehouses in the center of Auronzo, with their rustic and essential style with the Church of S. Giustina and Our Lady of Gracethey accompany you along the tree-lined avenue, making you feel immersed in an authentic and genuine atmosphere, where time seems to have stopped. You feel at home, welcomed by the warm hospitality of the locals and the beauty of the landscape.

Parish Church of San Lucano Patron Saint of the Dolomites

Continue your walk to the parish church of **Saint Lucan**. This church, built in the 18th century, is an example of Baroque architecture and has an imposing façade decorated with statues and frescoes. Once inside, you will be fascinated by the interior decorations, including a beautiful pink marble altar and a frescoed ceiling with scenes from the life of San Lucano.



The book "Il Cadore ei Benedettini di Follina e Busco" attests the first mention of the church of San Lucano on 11 January 1229, when Widolino da Auronzo mentions it in his will. In 1439 the church was consecrated and in 1839 it was decided to rebuild it due to the increase in population.

The architect**Palatines**of Pieve di Cadore chose the place where the new church was to be built, but then the project was entrusted to Giuseppe**Segusini**of Feltre. The works began in 1851 and were completed in 1856, when the church was consecrated. The church organ, built by GB De Lorenzi of Vicenza, is a particular phonochromic instrument with two keyboards. The current bell tower, which dates back to the 1920s, replaces the medieval one which was now in danger of collapsing and is in perfect harmony with the church.

Visit to the church of the Madonna delle Grazie

It was built by the Auronzani in 1738 with the aim of ending the war with Dobbiaco for the possession of the pastures. The church was dedicated to the **Our Lady of Grace** and construction was completed in 1752.



The interior is characterized by an octagonal plan and on the altar there is a painting of the Madonna delle Grazie. The architectural style of the church is late Baroque and the polychrome majolica roof is beautiful, with a spectacular view of the entire surrounding area. It is interesting to stop and look at the wrought iron flagpole depicting the famous three-pricked rooster that the legend speaks of.

The Roman sanctuary

The**Roman Sanctuary**of Auronzo di Cadore is an archaeological site located behind the town cemetery. It is composed of at least two phases of construction dating back to Roman times, where

the cult of the deities called was celebrated " *Masters*". The sanctuary was equipped with a writing system typical of the Veneto region of the time, derived from Etruscan models. The cultural and naturalistic path to reach the sanctuary was renovated in 2016 and can be accessed for free. In addition to history, the place also offers a panoramic view of the town and the surrounding mountains. The Roman Sanctuary of Auronzo di Cadore is just one of the testimonies of the Roman era present in the area, together with the remains of the Roman road located in the nearby village of Lozzo.



A "JURASSIC" SUMMER IN THE DOLOMITES: IN AURONZO DI CADORE PREHISTORIC REPTILES "REVIVE" BETWEEN SCIENCE, CINEMA AND LIFE-SIZE REPRODUCTIONS

It will be a real peaceful invasion that will involve over the course of the summer Auronzo of Cadore, a tourist resort in the Belluno area known for the Tre Cime di Lavaredo, transforming it into the "land of dinosaurs": from June 14th to September 7th 2025 20 life-size reproductions of specimens that lived in the Mesozoic will populate the symbolic places of the territory, protagonists of the widespread exhibition" At Dawn of the Three Peaks - The Dinosaurs", promoted by the Municipality of Auronzo di Cadore in collaboration with the Magnifica Comu-

nità di Cadore and the Municipality of Danta di Cadore. You can meet them while walking around Lake Santa Caterina, while they mirror themselves in the water to drink or start hunting, as well asin the halls of the Palazzo Corte Metto Museum, in dialogue with the collections of the naturalistic section and the fossils from the Bruno Berti Collection and the loan from the Ligabue Foundation (kept by the "Le Radici della Vita" Museum of Danta di Cadore, partner of the project), while a 9-meter Allosaurus will dominate the valley from the Auronzo Refuge, at 2,333 meters above sea level, the undisputed guardian of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo.

The widespread exhibition intertwines science, cinema and emotions, ensuring an immersive encounter with the great rulers of the Earth from millions of years ago in a journey that involves an entire valley, as has never happened before in Italy. Evolution of the exhibition hosted by the Vittorino Cazzetta Museum which in 2022 brought 15 thousand visitors to Selva di Cadore (Belluno), the Auronzo di Cadore project rewinds the tape of history and takes the territory - rich in traces of the passage of dinosaurs, such as the footprints that can be observed by going around the three refuges Auronzo, Lavaredo and Locatelli on the Tre Cime - back to a remote era: throughout the valley and at high altitude you will have the sensation of reliving the Mesozoic atmosphere and being part of it. An important role will be played by references to major Hollywood productions, from Jurassic Park to Jurassic World Dominion, the latter partly filmed right in Auronzo.

AT THE MUSEUM OF PALAZZO CORTE METTO. In a

to the discoveries made in the Dolomites, to the formation of this corner of the Triassic "world" and to the animals that populated it, with particular attention to archosaurs and the first dinosaurs. Another section will be dedicated to the great discoveries on Italian territory, which began in the 1980s also following local findings. The internal itinerary of the museum will include, among others, the reconstruction of Ciro, the famous cub of Scipionyx samniticus, found in Benevento, and the Tethysadros insularis called Antonio, found in the Fisherman's Village of Duino - Aurisina (Trieste). You will also find an indepth study dedicated to successful films in which the Tre Cime appear and an entertaining anthology of errors contained in Hollywood films. Furthermore, the section on avian dinosaurs, with the transition from dinosaurs to birds, will be integrated into the museum's fauna rooms, offering visitors a precise and captivating look at the evolution of these animals. This exhibition will also see the presence of real dinosaur fossils. from the Bruno Berti collections and on loan from the Ligabue Foundation, preserved at the "Le Radici della Vita" Museum in Danta di Cadore.

AT THE LAKE OF SANTA CATERINA. Along the walkon the right bank of Lake Santa Caterina, in a panoramic position, seven life-size dinosaur reproductions will be placed: the specimens will be reflected in the water, recalling scenes from films. Specifically, it will be abouttwo Italian dinosaurs, a Saltriovenator and the titanosaur Tito, and five American Cretaceous dinosaurs including the famous T-Rex, protagonists of the films Jurassic Park and Jurassic World. Particular attention will be paid to the Diplodocus, a dinosaur over 20 meters long and very similar to the one seen walking in Lake D'Antorno, on the slopes of the Tre Cime, in the film Jurassic World Dominion.

TO THE THREE PEAKS OF LAVAREDO. The exhibition will be spread across the territory involving the refuges

of the Three Peaks and the Ribotta area, an important centre of interest for children and families thanks to the presence of the Fun Bob and the Tre Cime Avventure Park. Outside the three refuges - the Auronzo Refuge, the Lavaredo Refuge and the Locatelli Refuge - there will be somepanels that will illustrate local discoveries, with a reference to the films dedicated to the dinosaurs present and to the Tre Cime. Furthermore, at the Tre Cime car park, in a panoramic position, there will be a Allosaurus, a 9-meter-long dinosaur that appears among the protagonists of the Jurassic World saga.

TO THE RIBOTTA, finally, you will be able to admire the life-size reproduction of the **Parasaurolophus**, an installation that will once again recall a scene from Jurassic World.

The Gogna Baths

The history of the **Gogna baths** dates back at least to the Roman period, when the thermal waters were known for their healing properties. During the **Middle Ages**, the baths were used primarily to treat skin diseases, but also became popular among nobles seeking relief from chronic illnesses. Today we can only see the remains of what was once a popular place. The **source**It is still there, with its characteristic smell of sulphur perceptible among the trees of this **mysterious forest**. The visit is recommended to everyone, it is interesting to retrace part of the history of Cadore in a short walk a few steps from the Piave and

The Roman sanctuary of Auronzo

The Roman sanctuary of Auronzo di Cadore is a testimony of the Roman age located near the center of Auronzo. The cultural and naturalistic itinerary It was redeveloped in 2016 and can be visited for free.

The excavations have revealed at least two phases of construction of the sanctuary, with the cult dedicated to the deities called "Masters".

The area is also important for local writing, with the discovery of a stylus among the ruins of the sanctuary.

The route is made even more interesting by the panels placed along the way and by the **panoramic position**on the mountain.

The path that leads to the Roman ruins is asphalted, therefore also easy to walk with a stroller.

The Corte Metto Palace

The palace was the seat of the "Museum of Flora, Fauna and Mineralogy" since the 1950s.

The naturalistic collection of the exhibition, initially created thanks to the passion of some private citizens, was enriched over time with newfaunal specimensof local and extra-European origin, of minerals, rock and fossil samples, of ethnographic finds relating to the mining activity that took place in the mines of Val d'Ansiei.

The spaces: on the first floor the section ""Life and Earth Science", on the second floor "Archeology" in the fourth "Minerals and Mines".

Tour of Lake Auronzo

Auronzo di Cadore is perfect for exploring The main reason for deciding to walk in Auronzo is the possibility of admiring the many panoramas and photogenic landscapes characteristic of this corner of Veneto. You don't have to be a walker, the walk is for everyone.

WHERE TO PARK.

We recommend two car parks that can accommodate several cars. They are both located at the end of **Zardus Street**, the first on the right

(lake front) near the Bar Bucintoro, the second is on the other side of the bridge on the right.

The route we propose is very panoramic, flat and suitable for families: it consists of a tour of Lake Auronzo, approximately 6 km long.

Also known as Lake Santa Caterina, it is artificial, created with a dam capable of "trapping" the emerald green waters that characterize it.

The path is unpaved and well beaten. From the par-



indicated you are already very close to the first panoramic point: the Transacqua bridge where flags from all over the world waving will welcome you and mark the start of your tour. This is an excellent location to take some souvenir photos.

Continuing over the bridge, follow the asphalt road to the Stella Alpina chalet where there is a children's playground with a fun pulley and pedal boat rental.

From the Stella Alpina chalet the paved road gives way to the well-beaten dirt path. You will be captivated by the sounds of the fresh forest that you will cross, here there is no shortage of tables and benches for a picnic or simply to rest a bit.

The path continues through the thick woodland vegetation on the right while on the left it will be impossible to miss the second panoramic point: **the wooden bridge**that connects the shores of the lake, also "him" perfect for a memorable shot. From here, crossing it you can return to the starting point (halving the tour of the lake) but we recommend that you continue towards the Santa Caterina dam. Impressive with its jump of several meters. Cross it and - keeping the lake on your left, after a short stretch on the national road, continue along the beaten track that will take you to the Juventus hotel, an excellent place to have an ice cream.

The itinerary is almost finished, keep the lake on your left and you will arrive at the **equipped sandy beach**, where the beautiful wooden walkway will indicate your arrival point, a few steps from the bridge from which you departed.

The first one playground is located a short distance from the public parking lot, at Chalet Stella Alpina, reachable by crossing the bridge of via Zardus. Here the little ones can try their hand at rope bridges, a short zip line and the inevitable slides.

The second oneIt is located in front of the Juventus bar, reachable by road or - from the other bank - by the beautiful wooden bridge that cuts the lake in half. Here there are benches in the shade where you can sit and watch the little ones playing, perhaps enjoying a nice ice cream.

*The third park*games is located near the sandy beach, near the public parking lots and more precisely in front of the Bar Bucintoro. Here, in addition to the swings and slides, a wooden installation in the shape of a boat will be a must-see

FUN BOB

Your children will love this experience that will surely make you smile too. The Fun Bob in Auronzo di Cadore is the longest bobsleigh track on rails in Europe. The activity consists of going up with the special system that takes you to the starting point at an altitude of 1361 meters above sea level. Mount Agudo 360° PANORAMA

Two km from the centre of Auronzo you will find the Monte Agudo area. Over the years, the hill has become an attractive hub not only for winter tourism but also for summer tourism. The two chairlifts, including a modern four-seater with automatic coupling, take you from the start (Taiarezze, 900 m) in just over 15 minutes. There are three refuges ready to welcome you, two located at the arrival of the four-seater, the perfect destination for those waiting their turn at the Fun Bob or simply to spend a few hours relaxing. While the third, the Monte Agudo refuge (1,573 m) is located at a panoramic point par excellence over the town, the lake and the Auronzo Dolomites, with an excellent view of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo. So you can't miss out on a photo opportunity. A variant of the Alta Via n° 5 also leads to the Monte Agudo refuge.



FUN BOB IN AURONZO DI CADORE

If you think that the mountains are boring and there is nothing fun to do, we are sorry to prove you wrong. An activity that will put a smile on the faces of the little ones but also the older ones. The activity in question is called "descent with the Fun Bob", wouldn't you try it too?

THE EXPERIENCE

After leaving your car in the free parking located a short distance from the **Fun Bob**, in a few steps you arrive at a photogenic wooden bridge where - after having crossed it - you pro-


following to the right you arrive at Tre Cime Adventure Park while to the left you reach the arrival of the Fun Bob track.

It's hard not to see the**very long snake**of aluminum that winds down the slope, impossible not to hear the amused shouts of those who are already coming down.

No sooner said than done, the**ticket**in a structure above which there is a large screen in which a video illustrates the experience. Through a fast ski lift in a few minutes you arrive at the departure point, at an altitude of 1361 meters above sea level. In a couple of minutes

the operators fasten their seat belts and explain that to start you have to move a lever forward, while to brake you just have to pull it back, nothing complicated. Ready, steady, go!!

Who likes it?**the adrenaline**it launches itself into the straight, reaches a speed of 45 km/h and has fun. Between hairpin bends and curves you can moderate the speed, enjoy the**panorama**and the sense of freedom that only emotions like this can convey. The valley is getting closer but there is time for one last quick sprint.



An experience for everyone, a really fun activity. The Fun Bob is absolutely safe to the point that each bob is equipped with 3 different brakes to avoid any danger. Children under 7 years old can try this experience accompanied by their parents. From 8 years old onwards it is possible to use the Fun Bob in complete autonomy.

Adventure is an ingredient capable of making unforgettable experiences and transforming them into indelible memories, whether they are lived during a holiday, a weekend or a day of leisure. The Auronzo Adventure Park, an experience for adults but also for children, is in fact obvious to say that adventure appeals to everyone - obviously if experienced in total safety.

WHERE THE PARK IS LOCATED.We are located a couple of kilometers from the center of Auronzo di Cadore, in the Monte Agudo area. The parking lot is large, free and is literally a few meters from the adventure park. After leaving your vehicle, head towards the wooden bridge and cross it. On the left you will notice the Fun Bob, while if you continue to the right, crossing the woods you will arrive at the Tre Cime Adventure Park.

THE EXPERIENCE. At the sign that shows us the very short path to get to the adventure park. In the distance we look at the forest and - among the tops of the tall trees - we see people intent on climbing them using ropes and special walkways. We get closer and suddenly, above our heads, we see the zip lines, at high speed it passes over the Ansiei river reaching the other bank. We arrive at a structure where some guys are waiting for you. After buying the tickets, they explain to you in detail every aspect of the experience, focusing on the fundamental point of safety. In the meantime they provide you with harnesses where - using carabiners - you will always be safe.

READY, SET AND... GO!!Each of you can choose between the 5 available aerial routes, for all tastes, even for the most fearful, while for the little ones (from 3 to 5 years) there is the possibility of trying out game experiences in total safety.

Yellow Route.It is a path for the little ones, who under the strict supervision of their parents can also live an experience among the trees, without a harness through a mandatory path.

Light Green Path. It is the first route and has an easy difficulty level; it allows you to become familiar with the first suspended activities such as bridges and pulleys; it is a route with a maximum height of 1.5/2m, contains 7 activities and ends with a small zip line.

Dark Green Path. It is the second route with a medium/easy difficulty level; the difficulty of the various activities increases with the height which goes from 2 m to 4 m maximum; the activities of the route are 7 with a final zip line.

Blue Route. It is the third route in our park and is also the longest, it has a medium/difficult difficulty level. The height from the ground goes from 6 m to a maximum of 10 m, it contains 15 activities and ends with a final zip line.

Red Route. It is the fourth route and to access it you need to be at least 13 years old and have completed the previous routes. It has a high level of difficulty and is very complicated due to the activities that require a good amount of strength and balance. It has a height that varies between 12 m and 14 m high, it has 6 activities and ends with a long zip line. It is a "physical" route.

Zip line over the Ansiei river. It is an independent route, it starts from a large larch in the park and returns to the park, 300 meters of rope, suspended above the Ansiei river.

The park has 43 platforms and a zip line that crosses the Ansiei River:

Misurina is the highest hamlet of the Municipality of Auronzo di Cadore. It is defined as the "Pearl of the Dolomites" and from these few words you can already imagine the beauty and magnificence of the place

LAKE MISURINA IN SUMMER

You don't have to be a nature lover to appreciate the **Misurina lake**, its beauty is not a subjective factor.

Lake Misurina is the largest Alpine lake in Cadore and lies at an altitude of 1755 m. It is difficult to forget the feeling of pure amazement felt when you visit Lake Misurina for the first time. It appears suddenly behind a curve, it seems to be waiting for you in the blue painted blue. Sitting on the shore you get lost in its colors, amongthe mountains reflected in the turquoise of its waters, while the sun warms accompanied by a fresh summer breeze.

WHAT TO DO AT LAKE MISURINA

One of the experiences to do at Lake Misurina is the walk along its perimeter, a bit to find refreshment but above all to enjoy the enchanting atmosphere that characterizes it. If you don't like walking, don't worry, with a few steps you can reach one of the many benches where you can sit and enjoy an incomparable feeling of extremeRelax. If you love walking, Lake Misurina is the starting point for countless Trekking. From the easiest to the most challenging, hundreds of trails wind through the slopes that lead to the discovery of refuges and unforgettable views. It is interesting to learn about the history of the great war fought between these peaks and the fascinating legends capable of awakening the imagination of even the greatest. One of the less challenging routes that we can recommend is the tour of Lake Misurina. You can start from one of the

parking lots in the area and then proceed clockwise or counterclockwise along a completely flat route of about 3.2 km. The trail takes about 45 minutes to complete and is suitable for everyone: families, couples, the elderly or children. The trail is well maintained and the wooden walkways that characterize it allow you to see the lake and itspanoramasfrom different angles skimming the water. During your tour you will be accompanied by the characteristic sounds of the forest: the woodpecker preparing its nest, the "splash" of the lake trout, always hunting for flies, dragonflies and the relaxing gurgling of the streams that feed the lake with the crystalline waters that characterize it.

The summerIt's the perfect season to see the Misurina lakefrom a different perspective: from the water. Yes, because another super activity that we recommend is to rent a rowing boat or a pedal boat to explore the lake while fully enjoying the intimacy that only aboatin the middle of a beautiful alpine lake can offer.



One of the most beautiful cycle paths: Auronzo/Misurina

From the beautiful town of Auronzo di Cadore, which stands directly above the spectacular Lake Santa Caterina, also called Lake Auronzo, begins the cycle path that connects this lake to the equally spectacular Lake Misurina. The route is suitable for everyone, but the outward journey is all uphill with a difference in altitude of about 923 m. For the less trained, it may be more fun to ride the cycle path on an e-bike. The total distance to reach Lake Misurina from Auronzo is 21.7 km.



THE ROUTE. The start of the route is located on the western side of the Zardus Street bridge. north of the Auronzo lake. Impossible to miss: the flags of different nations placed above it, in addition to welcoming you, will mark the start of your two-wheeled adventure. Immediately after the bridge, continue on the dirt path that immediately immerses itself in the greenery. The first part of the cycle path winds without excessively steep climbs along the bottom of the Ansiei Valley, with an average gradient of 3.5%. From this point the cycle path is well marked and it is almost impossible to get lost, along the way you will find signs indicating the place where you are, the difference in altitude you have already faced and the distance from the arrival. Countless rest areas all in wood, with the rack for the bikes, benches and tables - also covered by canopies where you can sit for a snack or rest a bit. The cycle pathalready in the initial part it offers a privileged view of the rushing river with its crystalline waters that gurgle among the white stones smoothed by the power of the water. The first bridge you will cross is that of

Malon, where you have to continue keeping the river on the left. Then in order you reach Taiarezze, Giralba, Val Marzon, P.te Argentiera, Pralongo, Domenico Savio, Palus San Marco arriving at the mythical Somadida Forest which is located at an altitude of 1136 meters above sea. level. This forest characterized by tall trees seems shrouded in an aura of mystery that has inspired myths and legends of a unique territory that is all to be discovered. The Somadida Forest marks the beginning of the second part of the itinerary: the hardest. Yes, because the slope of the climbs increases guite a bit but the beauty of this place will repay you for every effort. Continuing you arrive atGood Valley, to then reachMisurina crossroadsand get to the Misurina lake, directly in front of the little church of Col de Varda. The view from the little church opens onto the underlying lake of Misurina and the surrounding mountains, it is impossible not to be enraptured. From this point you can decide whether to stop at the lake for some souvenir shots, continue towards the Three Peaks of Lavaredo or more simply return to Auronzo di Cadore enjoying a 21.7 km descent.

What is your perfect view? perfection is given only by nature, by the mountain peaks that are reflected in a turquoise lake, by the scent of the forest and by the green of plants born and grown in uncontaminated spaces. The goal of many is to visit mountain lakes so these magnificent bodies of water cannot be missing from your experiences.

ANTORNO LAKE. The smallest of the three is Lake Antorno which is located a very short distance from Misurina (about 2 km) and about 16 km from Auronzo. First of all, how to get there and where to park? You can leave your car in the free parking lot located on the left of the lake before the Chalet Lago d'Antorno or at the Cadini car park along Via Monte Piana about 800 metres away. Lake Antorno is truly a gem. The walkway that leads to its discovery, although short, is characterised by beautiful little bridges in wood and walkways that allow you to enter the forest located at its end towards the mountain. Very beautiful and characteristic its natural island that makes it unique and spectacular in every aspect, especially when the sky is blue and the reflection returns a perfect speculation. The water of the lake is not very deep and it is not uncommon to see rainbow trout that slowly swim in the placid waters.

LAKE MISURINA. "Misurina then began to cry... She cried so much that she completely melted. Her tears became a lake, the beautiful blue lake called Misurina that is located at the foot of Mount Sorapis, in the Dolomites." This is the sad epilogue of the famous legend of Lake Misurina. You will find this and other legends in the illustrated book by Auronzo "Diary in the history of the Ansiei Valley". Lake Misurina gives you the opportunity to rent a pedal boat or a rowing boat and explore it from a different point of view or the classic walk on its shores, with its many benches where you can sit and contemplate its beauty and relax with the sense of calm that the

its waters are able to infuse. The l**Misurina needle**from any point you look at it looks like a postcard. From the area start most of the paths that lead to the exploration of the surrounding mountains and remote refuges to conquer step by step.

LAKE AURONZO. Lake Santa Caterina is a lake that strikes and leaves a mark, impossible to forget its pristine emerald waters. The Auronzo di Cadore area offers many services and organization is not lacking. You can easily rent a bike, entertain the children in the numerous playgrounds that are located on the shores of the lake or simply relax on lakeside walks that create feelings of peace and relaxation.

FOR SPORT FISHING LOVERS. Auronzo and Misurina, with the Fishing Basin No. 2 of the Ansiei River and its two splendid lakes, is the ideal place for this sport. Since 2014, the new Catch & Release area upstream of Lake Santa Caterina has been active, for a length of 900 linear meters, with the presence of 90% of Danubian Grayling; while this year a new C&R area has been set up in Misurina (Zone "S": Larice Palui - Lake Misurina with reservation). The Fishing Basin is equipped with areas for the disabled and parking.

ANTORNO LAKE

A place to photograph in the Auronzo/ Misurina area is undoubtedly Lake Antorno. A small mountain lake located a very short distance from Misurina (2 km) and 27 km from Auronzo.

LAKE MISURINA

Lake Misurina is certainly another protagonist of the area and

It is definitely worth a stop for a photo.
The best place to take the photo is from the parking lot which is just a few meters from the main road.


THE THREE PEAKS OF LAVAREDO

Who has never heard of the 3 Peaks of Lavaredo? An iconic place and a UNESCO heritage site, a place that is hard to forget. To see them up close there is no better place in the world than the Veneto side. precisely from the Auronzo refuge which is located a short distance from Misurina and Auronzo di Cadore, From here a walkway will take you to discover the 3 Peaks, it's up to you to find the best angle for a shot that will last forever.

LAKE OF SANTA CATERINA AURONZO

Perhaps the least known of the three places but from which you can take wonderful shots of the Santa Caterina Dam.

The stop is a must to immortalize all the beauty of the town, the lake and the wonderful mountains that surround it.





From Cadini to Marmarole, from Sorapis to the Tre Cime di Lavaredo

Legendsand mountain is a consolidated binomial. To explain certain phenomena, the spread of a particular flower or the formation of majestic peaks, we resort to popular tales that are handed down from generation to generation each time with different nuances, so much so that sometimes the original story is no longer recognized. This is the case of **Three Peaks of Lavaredo**, but also of the **Cadini di Misurina**, **of Sorapis and of Lake Misurina**, **of Marmarole**. Between one legend and another, you follow ever-new paths to discover these mountains, enjoying breathtaking views of the imposing Dolomite peaks.

THE STONE ASCETICS OF CADINI

Legend has it that a group of ascetics had found a place in the middle of the mountains, above the Ansiei Valley, right in the place where the Misurina Falls. Men worshipped the sun and raised their hands in prayer towards the sky at sunset. It was during one of these prayers that, to escape evil, men were transformed into stone giants so as to rise gloriously above earthly temptations. Even today, where the Dolomites rise between towers and rocky pinnacles, the peaks of the Cadini appear like hands clasped in prayer surrounded by eternal snow. There are several routes that penetrate the mountain group of the Cadini, of varying degrees of difficulty depending on the preparation. On the southern side, for example, a pleasant panoramic walk connects the Col de Varda refugeat 2,115 metres above sea level, reachable by chairlift, and the Carpi City Shelterat 2,110 metres above sea level. The difference in altitude is just 270 metres but the route is a real balcony overlooking the mountain chain Marmaras, the imposing Sorapis and the majestic Crystal, until the Tofane which form the backdrop to Cortina. You walk among the mountain pines and then among Swiss pines and clearings until Maraia Fork, a beautiful grassy saddle from which to enjoy the Cadini spires. You can decide to return by chairlift or on foot, tackling a difference in altitude of about 640 meters. The most trained can easily cover the entire itinerary on foot.

THE TEARS OF KING SORAPIS

The Sorapis Group It is made up of the central massif which in turn includes the Punta Sorapis at 3,205 metres above sea level, Fopa di Mattia at 3,155 metres, Croda Marcora at 3,154 metres and the Tre Sorelle at 3,005 metres. At his feet the wonderful Lake Sorapis, whose turquoise waters reflect the majestic peaks. A spectacle, thanks also to the particular shade of the lake. Legend has it that a spoiled and capricious little girl named Misurina asked her father, a kinggiant called Sorapis, to provide her with the All-I-Self mirror through which she could fi-

finally satisfy his infinite curiosity. The fairy of Monte Cristallogave the mirror to the king, but in exchange asked him to transform himself into a great mountain that could give some shade to his garden. daughter Misurina accepted the exchange and as soon as he had the mirror, his father transformed into the great mountain. His tears gave life to the Lake Misurina, whose many reflections would be the result of the magic mirror still kept in its waters. Trained athletes can try their hand at Sorapis Tourdedicating two days to trekking and planning two nights, one at Vandelli Refuge starting point of the ring, and one at the San Marco Refuge. A challenging but doable one-day itinerary is the one that Passo Tre Croci (1,805 m) reaches Forcella de Marcuoira at 2,307 metres above sea level passing through the Rifugio Vandelli at 1,928 metres above sea level. The circular route is just over 13 km long, with a total difference in altitude of 1,000 metres, and requires approximately 4 hours and 40 minutes of walking.


TANNA, THE QUEEN OF THE MARMAROLE

According to legend, the Marmaras are inhabited by the Croderes, beings devoid of feelings and with hearts of stone. Tanna is their queen. Tanna once renounced being queen and left the Marmaras for love, but soon her cruel husband abandoned her and her son. After several adventures, the son, wounded by his own father, died falling into a crevasse and his young wife let herself die on his body. At that point Tanna, forever deprived of love for men, returned to being the queen of Marmaras, cold in its beauty and proud of its rocks. To explore the Marmarole group you can start from the ski lifts of Mount Agudo and take the chairlift to the top of the wooded mountain at 1,573 metres above sea level where you will find the refuge of the same name. From here you can first reach Col of the Oxenand successfully the beautiful Pian dei Buoi, a large plateau with a panoramic view of the myths of Oltrepiave and Centro Cadore, from Cridola to Spalti di Toro up to

The route, without any difficulty, is nevertheless challenging due to its length of over 23 km, the overall difference in altitude of 1,400 metres and the travel time of approximately 7 hours.

THE Edelweiss OF THE THREE PEAKS

A legend could not be missing for the Three Peaks of Lavaredo: it is that of the edelweiss, of which there are however many different versions. One of these tells that when the Dolomites emerged from the waters, magical creatures came down to earth, good spirits who gave shape and life to flowers and plants. Thus were born forests of fir, larches and pines, mountain pine and rhododendron, meadows and flowers multiplied, every corner had its flower and its plant. The only land on which not even a flower grew was the great mountain of Lavaredo, naked and bare. One night the echo of its crying reached the beautifulfairy Samblanawho rose high into the sky and took a small, bright star in his hands. He placed it among the rocks of the highest of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo and transformed it into a wonderful star-shaped flower with velvety petals as white as snow. Thus, even the great mountain finally had its flower. In this case, the indicated itinerary is a great classic: the tour of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo. The starting point is the Auronzo Refuge at 2,320 metres above sea level, right under the southern face of the Tre Cime, from here you take the circular route that allows you to admire this masterpiece of nature. You pass through the Locatelli Refugeat 2,405 metres above sea level and the Col di Mezzo Forkat 2,315 meters: the Three Peaks stand out in all their majesty and grandeur, offering a breathtaking spectacle. The route is less than 10 km long, with a difference in altitude of 468 meters, travel time approximately 3 and a half hours.



HOW TO GET TO THE TRE CIME DI LAVAREDO. The Tre Cime di Lavaredo are located about 30 kilometers from Auronzo di Cadore. On the Veneto side there is only one road that leads to the **Three Peaks of Lavaredo**, it is therefore very difficult to go wrong. From the town of Auronzo, taking the provincial road 49, in about 35/40 minutes you can reach **Measuring cup**, from there, following via Monte Piana you will reach Lake Antorno. Once there, you can choose whether to park your car and continue on foot (about 7 km) or go directly to the Auronzo refuge.

THE PATHS TO BEST SEE THE 3 PEAKS OF LAVAREDO. Here's how to get directly under the three giants. After reaching the **Auronzo refuge**continue along the path **CAI 104**, a very well marked path, easy to follow and almost entirely without excessive differences in altitude, suitable for everyone. In about 40 minutes of walking you reach the **Lavaredo refuge** where we recommend filling your water bottles or stopping for a short break. From here the Tre Cime are right in front of you while towards the valley you will see the flowery pastures where the sound of cowbells echoes in the valley. Between these mountains the clouds move quickly creating light/dark games that are reflected between rocks and pastures.

From the Lavaredo refuge you can continue along the path**CAI 101**uphill for about 500 meters, you will reach the closest point to the Cime. Here is a perfect spot for a nice selfie or a high-impact panoramic photo. You don't want to leave this spectacular place without a memory, do you? Photo taken, from there you can continue to the Rifugio Locatelli along the path**CAI 101**or continue south-west on the CAI 105 path to Forcella di Mezzo then south-east until returning close to the**Auronzo Refuge**.

Online booking. Starting in summer 2025, access by car to the parking lot for the Tre Cime di Lavaredo will only be possible with an online reservation.

How to book parking and pay the toll

To reach the Tre Cime di Lavaredo by car, you must follow the new online booking method at www.auronzo.info. To access by public transport, visit www.dolomitibus.it

Winter Access. Beaten snow road, passable on foot, with snowshoes, mountaineering skis and with snowmobile service from Lake Antorno (info Tre Cime Service www.trecimeservice.com).

FROM THECOL DE VARDA TO CARPI CITY REFUGE

The Città di Carpi refuge is another destination that we recommend seeing. It is located in the Auronzo di Cadore area (precisely on the Maraia fork at an altitude of 2110 meters, in the Cadini di Misurina group. The panorama that can be enjoyed from its terrace ranges**on the Marmarole, on the Sorapiss, Monte Cristallo, Tofane and on the Croda dei Toni.**

THE PATH.The trail starts from **Misurina lake**but for those who want to cut the itinerary it is possible to go up with the chairlift that arrives at **Col de Varda refuge**. If you prefer to undertake the excursion from Misurina without the chairlift using the path **CAI 116**((it is located near the ski lift). The path immediately climbs with a certain slope on the western side of the mountain. In about 50 minutes you reach a fork in the road, on the left you continue towards the Col De Varda refuge from where you can enjoy a beautiful view of the lake and the valley (it is worth taking a few more steps to reach it). On the right you continue on the side of the mountain along a short descent, a moment to catch your breath and enjoy the panorama that opens up between the surrounding peaks. The descent ends in a few minutes and you start climbing again along the path **CAI 120**. Beautiful woods look like untouched forests. You get to **Conca Maraia**where you can see flowery meadows and woodland clearings, fields of rhododendrons accompany you with the ringing of cowbells. The path continues uphill and on the left there is the refuge that appears to you as a beautiful oasis. Here you are finally on its terrace, from which you can enjoy the view of the **Sorapis** which seems to shine with its own light while the Cadini di Misurina group is unmistakable with its jagged and mysterious panorama. The entire itinerary that we

have described can be covered with two wheels indicated

WHAT THE REFUGE OFFERS. The refuge inaugurated 51 years ago, precisely on September 13, is dedicated to Captain Manfredo Tarabili Castellani of the Pieve di Cadore Battalion. The refuge was expanded in the 80s and today has 60 internal places, 45 external places and various rooms capable of hosting up to 32 people. Città Carpi draws energy from solar panels. Open from June 14th to October 5th, it is also open during the winter weekends (from Christmas to Easter). CARDUCCI REFUGE

The refuge is located in the heart of the grandiose and wild rocky amphitheater formed by the eastern bastions of Croda dei Toni and Monte Giralba di Sopra. From this wonderful balcony you can enjoy a vast panorama towards Croda di Ligonto, the Crissin, Bivera, Cridola groups until reaching Monfalconi. Then just go to the nearby Giralba fork to enjoy an equally wonderful panorama towards Crode Fiscaline, Cima Undici, Popera and the amphitheater of Alta Val Fiscalina.



THE PATH.From Auronzo di Cadore localityGiralba-Pian della Velma(parking), reachable by a deviation on the regional road 48 for Misurina. Go up the entire Val Giralba on path no. 103, altitude difference approximately 1370 m. 5.00 hours. From the Auronzo Refuge to the Tre Cime di Lavaredo 2320 m (access to the 3 Cime di Lavaredo car parks by paying a toll at the toll booth located immediately after Lake Antorno), to the Lavaredo Refuge, shortly after on the right for the Refuge

Pian di Cengia 2528 m along path no. 104, descend to the Zsigmondy-Comici refuge and then to the Carducci refuge along path no. 103, difference in altitude approximately 600 m. 4.00 hours. From the Tre Cime/Locatelli refuge to the Pian di Cengia refuge along path no. 101 1.30 hours then as above, total 3.00 hours. (From the Auronzo refuge total 5.30 hours).

VARIANTS.From the Val Marzongoing up the Val di Cengia along path no. 1107 until you meet path no. 104 up to the Pian di Cengia refuge, difference in altitude approximately 1250 m. 3.00 hours. Then as above. (From Val Marzon to the Carducci refuge total 5.30 hours). From Val Marzon going up the Val del Marden along path no. 106 until you meet path no. 107 up to the Sella dei Ghiaioni, difference in altitude approximately 1280 m. 4.30 hours (see then the Croda dei Toni tour); From the Battaglion Cadore bivouac 2219 m, descending the Val Stallata along the equipped path no. 109 up to the Pian delle Salere junction 1365 m, then going up the Val Giralba along path no. 103 up to the Carducci refuge 2297 m.

MARAIA MARAIA


If you like views, good food and clean, crisp mountain air, this article is for you: here you will find useful information about Malga Maraia, one of the most beautiful mountain huts in the Auronzo Misurina area.

HOW TO GET THERE. Incar/bicycle: if you are not able to reach the mountain hut on your own, you can also get there by car. From Auronzo of Cadorefollow the directions for Measuring cupvia the Regional Road 48. Once you reach km 138+500 you will see a large sign on the right indicating Malga Maraia, from there in a few minutes you will reach the destination. Footpath from the Cristallo Hotel: the Cristallo Hotel is located along the regional road 48 about 5 km from Misurina and 18 km from Auronzo di Cadore. From here the travel time is 1 hour and a half, with a difference in altitude of 300 m. Take the small road that crosses the meadows above the hotel. From there the actual path begins that winds through a forest of red firs. You will arrive at an asphalt road, after having passed it take the forest road that climbs with a slight slope and among the larches, maples and firs you will arrive at the malga. Alternative mountain bike path: from Col De Varda chairlifthead to the right and take the path that leads to the little church from which

you can enjoy a beautiful view of the lake below. From here, take the cycle path towards Auronzo for 190 m. On your left you will find a sign indicating "Malga Maraia" and take path 120B. The length of the entire itinerary is about 7 km and the difference in altitude is 220 m slightly uphill. A simple route suitable for everyone. If you are not very fit, we recommend using an e-bike to fully enjoy the view.

MALGA MARAIA: WHY GO THERE. The first reason is undoubtedly the cuisine. Here you will be spoiled for choice: from typical dishes to grills. The cold cuts are excellent while their desserts are a delicacy not to be missed. Another reason is the panorama: the green pastures that characterize the area are a perfect setting to take some souvenir photos and to relax, perhaps lying down for a few minutes among the scented flowers and the green grass, watching the clouds that seem to chase each other in the sky. The mountain hut, in addition to being a very popular destination during the summer, is a jewel in the crown for winter hiking enthusiasts who can reach it on foot, with snowshoes or with skins.

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History of the Mount Piana

In the far north of Veneto stands the **Mount Piana** along an imaginary border that has existed since the times of the Serenissima, dividing the Republic of Venice from the Austrian Empire. Today, the same border is administrative in nature and separates the Veneto from the autonomous province of Bolzano. It is precisely because of this characteristic that part of the history of Italy has been written among its rocks, mosses and sporadic trees.

The story we are telling you is about battles that took place during the Great War right on the plateau of Mount Piana, the only Italian point of advantage from a military point of view compared to the Austrians. On May 24, 1915, Austria-Hungary declared war on Italy and so 8 battalions of very young Italians were sent to Mount Piana and its valleys, ready to defend their homeland with their lives. Also on May 24 at 8:30 a burst of machine gun fire from the nearby Mount Rudohit the Italian army busy building the road from Measuring cupleads to Mount Piana causing the first casualties. June 7, 1915: Austrian artillery began to target the Italian army at around 4 in the morning. It was a dark night and a storm was raging, under the cover of darkness two Austrian groups of soldiers arrived in the western basin and quickly neutralized the Italian sentries. In a short time atremendous battleThe clashes were even more fierce and bloody in the vicinity of the Carducci pyramid, from there the Austrians managed to penetrate the Italian trenches but suffered a strong counterattack. Given the heavy losses on the Austrian front, to limit the damage, they re-established the border on the northern plateau and after a few hours the Italians regained possession of the southern plateau. From the following day both the Italians and the Austrians began

the construction of deep trenches protected by barbed wire. The young men fought in inhuman conditions: in the cold, in the frost, with little to eat and with inadequate clothing. In winter the conditions worsened and both armies thought about strengthening their positions. In the months that followed there were several clashes with heavy losses but in the end 2 years of clashes led to nothing, the two armies fought each other on a handkerchief of land without obtaining victory. The truth was that avalanches, cold and accidents along the very difficult paths caused more victims than the clash itself. On the Mount PianaMore than 14,000 soldiers on both sides lost their lives.

MONTE PIANA TODAY. To commemorate the tragic events of this mountain, between 1977 and 1981 the historic open-air museum of Monte Piana was established, which can be visited free of charge. The trenches were rearranged thanks to the work of the group "friends of the Dolomites". The tunnels, walkways and stairways of the time were also rebuilt. Nowadays, retracing these walkways is nothing short of exciting, and thinking back to the deeds of the young Italians who lost their lives in those trenches is shocking.

What to see? The first stop we recommend is to visit the little church which is located on the right of the Bosi refugereachable by climbing the steps. In front of it it is difficult not to see the cannon that, towering over the area, seems to still want to defend the valley below. From the Bosi refuge there are several paths that allow you to see and visit numerous trenches until you reach the legendary Carducci pyramid, built in memory of the poet's visit. From there, continuing along the path, you reach the cross that marks the arrival at the summit. Walking north you reach the friendship bell placed on the old front line on the occasion of the anniversary of the end of the war. Absolutely not to be missed are the historical guided tours of the places of the Great War with Antonella Fornari.

Historic trail of the open-air museum Monte Piana

We have some important events of this place on History of Monte Piana while continuing to read you will discover some routes of Monte Piana in an interesting historical panoramic itinerary.

THE PATHS, THE ROUTE. From Misurina, at the height of the Dolomiti Des Alpes hotel, turn right keeping the lake on your right along via Giude Alpine until the parking lot in front of the Camping alla Baita, a few meters from the bar restaurant la Genzianella. You can leave your car there. Precisely in front of the parking lot, (at 12 o'clock) there is a small shack, in the same trajectory here is Mount Piana with its characteristic shape that resembles a panettone; the route starts right from here. Leaving the shack behind you, you proceed for a stretch without any difference in height along which we recommend you stop to admire this valley which from that point of view - is even more spectacular. The route climbs through narrow hairpin bends for about 6 km, with a difference in height of 565 meters you arrive directly in front of the Bosi refuge. From June to October it is possible to quickly reach the refuge with a Jeep/ taxi service while in winter there is a snowmobile service with an adrenaline-filled sled descent. Leaving the Bosi refuge on your right, you continue to climb along a narrow bend that takes you directly above the refuge. Continuing for 400 metres you

arrives at a small pyramid of rocks that was built by the Alpine troops in honor of the mythical poet Joshua Carducci. In 1892 during his stay in this area the poet wrote "Ode to Cadore' where he spoke of the beauty of these places and of the heroic deeds of Calvi. It is said that Giosuè Carducci wanted to climb to the top of Mount Piana, right where the northernmost border of the Venetian Republic passed, where the pyramid stands today. From this point you can follow the signs of the historic path that leads to discover the numerous trenches with regular and tortuous paths, the dangerous walkways that appear as if drawn between the rock walls of the nearby slopes dotted with tunnels dug into the rock by young men who fought furiously. In this plateau there are several paths that cross each other but wherever you look you will be captivated by the great beauty that surrounds you. The unusual shape of this mountain allows you to have a 360 view in one of the most beautiful panoramas of the Dolomites: the very photographable Three Peaks of Lavaredo, the majestic group of the Sorapis, Mount Cristallo up to the mysterious Cadini di Misurina. On Monte Piana many young people lost their lives for a war that seems so far away. Today among the bomb holes covered with green meadows families sit for a picnic and young people kiss in the sun. Yes, things change but I think it is important not to forget, so as not to repeat mistakes that man often makes by starting wars that have always led nowhere.

Discover the Beauty, Stay Aware

Trekking in the mountains is a fantastic experience, but it is important to do it in a safe and conscious way, and it is also important to respect the beauty of the environment that surrounds us.

Here are some helpful pointers:

- 1Preparation:Before leaving, find out about the route, ask for information from experts and local Alpine Guides. Check the weather conditions and the difficulty of the trail. Bring a map, a compass or a GPS and make sure you have everything you need in your backpack: water, food, appropriate clothing, sunscreen, hat and first aid kit. Remember to always have your phone charged, but also not to rely only on technology, because in the mountains the signal can be absent.
- 2Clothing:wear comfortable hiking shoes and sturdy, preferably waterproof. Dress in layers, so you can easily adapt to temperature changes.
- 3Behavior on the trail:Walk respectfully directions and signals. Keep a steady pace and do not run, to conserve energy and respect other hikers. Do not leave waste along the trail: take everything you have brought with you and use the bins or special containers for waste. RESPECT NATURE: do not pick plants or flowers and do not disturb wild animals.
- 4Safety:Do not take on routes that are too difficult or pedangerous if you are not experienced. Always tell someone your itinerary and expected times. In case of illness or accident, seek help immediately.
- 5Respect for others:Be courteous to other hikers-Zionists. Maintain a calm and respectful demeanor, avoiding excessive noise.IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT CALL 118.When calling, remember to provide information about the exact location of the accident, the activity carried out, the number of people involved and their conditions, the weather conditions and the telephone number from which you are calling.

By following these indications, your trekking will be not only pleasant, but also safe, aware and respectful of the mountain environment.

HOW TO GET THERE.Reach the **Somadida Forest**It's easy and the car parking is convenient and easy. From Auronzo take the regional road 48 towards Misurina. After 16.6 km you arrive at Palus San Marco, on the left you will notice the sign in the photo that indicates where you should turn to reach the free parking.

THE INFORMATION PATH. After parking your car, cross the small bridge and in a few steps you will arrive at the complex of pretty wooden houses that make up the Visitor Center "Three Sisters' where the path to discover the protected area begins. Immediately on the right you will find a map indicating the **Reserve** and the territory of which it is part while on the left here is the ecological center. Inside the characteristic wooden hut among the explanatory panels you can discover the animals that live in this area such as the badger, marten, ermine and fox. On display are some vases containing real snakes preserved in alcohol. A short distance away you reach the "library in the woods" where it is possible browse maps, guides, books of non-fiction and fiction also for children. The books can be consulted for free, we sat on a bench among the wooden structures deepening our knowledge of this interesting territory. In the same little house we find the exhibition on the history of the transport of red fir wood from Somadida at the Venice Arsenal: exhibition inaugurated in 2022. Behind the library in fact, there is a large raft built by hand in 2019, but this is certainly not a place where you would expect to find it, what do you say? There is a reason, and it is a real part of the history of the Veneto and Venice. This raft called Rasowas used to transport wood to Venice for the construction of ships, houses and more. The precious wood was transported downstream for kilometers and kilometers along the Piave Riverat times impetuous and difficult. It was a dangerous job and only a few were the brave ones who defied the forces of nature to reach Venice with this large raft made up only of logs that had to arrive in Arsenal.


THE BUTTERFLY GARDEN. Near the museum is the "butterfly garden", a restful and reflective place where in the spring and summer months it is possible to see some species of

butterflies. This space was created in 2012 as an environmental education tool aimed at bringing all visitors closer to a wonderful and little-known world: that of butterflies.butterfliesButterflies have a complexbiological cyclecharacterized by the metamorphosis of the caterpillar, which finds hospitality in a particular plant. The caterpillar plays a key role in pollination and this is why butterflies are one of the groups of insects best suited to monitor environmental changes. SOS butterflies is a network of gardens that aims to help butterflies live better, demonstrating how each of us can contribute in a small way to enlarge this network. If in your garden you favored some plants such as wild fennel, you would help protect these insects.

THE FOREST. Here all around you are surrounded by tall trees that make you feel small in comparison. Our walk took us along paths in the heart of this forest. Accompanied by the sound of dry branches and from the soft rustling of leaves that seemed to speak to us, we discovered flowers, mosses and lichens that characterise the undergrowth. A really nice route even for the little ones, visiting the Somadida forest is an experience that is definitely worth doing. Unfortunately in recent years we are witnessing a degradation of the forest in its flat part due to the infestation of bark beetles: a small scolvtid beetle insect that attacks the red firs causing them to dry up standing up. This is due both to the climate change with the high winter temperatures unable to destroy the insect both to the enormous quantity of dead wood present in the forest and throughout the Cadore after the**storm Vaia**of 2018 and which attracts the bark beetle.

THE CARABINIERI BIODIVERSITY DEPARTMENT OF VITTORIO

VENETO. As part of the institutional activity of Environmental Education promoted by the Carabinieri Forestali through the 28 CC Biodiversity Departments located throughout the country, the one in Vittorio Veneto annually organizes various events and visits of a naturalistic nature within the four State Reserves managed (
Somadida, Cansiglio, Bus de la Genziana Cave and Tovanella Valley). These initiatives are also carried out with the support and collaboration of local associations rooted in the territory such as, for Somadida, theThree Peaks Dolomites Consortium. For the Somadida Forest in particular, theBiodiversity Department of Vittorio Veneto offers weekly guided tours (usually on Tuesdays) in the months of July and August, through the on-site coordination of theCarabinieri Biodiversity Protection Unit of Palus San Marco.



VIGO out of the ordinary places

Vigo di Cadore, located in the Cadorino Oltrepiave, is immersed in the enchanting beauty of an uncontaminated Dolomite landscape and therefore perfect for those who love a relaxing holiday. The five hamlets that make up the Municipality(Vigo, Laggio, Pelos, Piniè and Treponti)They are rich in historical, cultural and naturalistic itineraries.Vigo contains real artistic treasures, such as the

a visit to the Casera Razzo plateau (1,800 m above sea level), an excellent panoramic point with large pastures that in winter transform into enchanting expanses of snow.

The fortifications of **With Vidal** completed in 1914, they were intended for the surveillance and defense of the Piave valley. They consist of a complex of structures, including two barracks and the armored battery, in addition to the works



Pievanale Church of San Martino, the Chapel of Sant'Orsola, whose frescoes make it a "small Scrovegni chapel", and the oldest church in the valley, Saint Margaret in Salagona, dating back to the 13th century. The Cadore Historical Library, founded in 1892, collects over 8,000 volumes and 550 parchments, constituting the most important collection center of testimonies that directly or indirectly concern the Cadore. Military works dating back to the First World War, including forts, tunnels and posts, are visible on the Col Ciampon and on Mount Tudaio, while at the foot of the latter you can visit the cave works of the" "Alpine Wall Littorio", built by Mussolini between 1939 and 1942. From a naturalistic point of view it is unmissable

complementary (trenches, caves, anti-aircraft positions, gun emplacements and bunkers). The Strada del Genio was built specifically to reach Col Vidal, labelled with this name by the locals because it was built by the Military Engineers.

The road climbs for 18 km with a difference in altitude of about 1,100 meters with a succession of hairpin bends and dry stone walls, from the town of Lozzo di Cadore towards Le Spesse to reach 'la monte. Military works including forts, tunnels and posts dating back to the First World War, never used, are visible in Vigo on Col Ciampon and on Monte Tudaio which in 2023 saw the inauguration of the **Bivouac From Rin Chiauriei**, while at the foot of the latter you can visit the cave works of the **Alpine Wall Littorio**, made by Mussolini between 1939 and 1942.

CASERA ROCKET PURE NATURAL The

Casera Razzo plateauDotted with huts, refuges and lodges, it is the starting point for numerous hiking itineraries and is ideal for practicing outdoor sports all year round. Among the various huts and malghe present on the plateau, the Casera di Razzo stands out, included in the Cheese Road: with the community recognition of the processing plant, it represents with its dairy products that added value that makes Casera Razzo a constant point of reference for tourists.

Favoured by a particularly snowy climate, in the cold season sporting and hiking activities continue every year until late spring.

There is a cross-country ski ring, the Ciampigotto ski lift with its two slopes, a snow park and many ski mountaineering itineraries suitable for excursions with "ciaspe".

CHURCHES AND HISTORICAL LIBRARY

VigoIt contains real artistic treasures, including some beautiful historic churches.

The Pievanale Church of San Martino, a parish since 1208 and rebuilt in 1559, preserves a true heritage of works of art from different historical periods: the triptych attributed to Antonio Rosso (1492), the wooden altarpiece by Valentino P. Besarel (1866), numerous works by the local artist Tommaso Da Rin.

The Chapel of St. UrsulaIt houses the most beautiful pictorial cycle in the Dolomite context. The frescoes make it a "small Scrovegni chapel" and demonstrate how Giotto's revolution also reached the Dolomites.

Santa Margherita in Salagona, the oldest church in the valley, dating back to the 13th century, follows the layout of the primitive churches in the area.

The pictorial cycle inside is a rare example, in the Belluno context, of the transition from Byzantine to Gothic art.

The Cadore Historical Library, founded in 1892 by Prof. Antonio Ronzon, to whom it is dedicated, constitutes the most important collection centre for testimonies that directly or indirectly concern Cadore. The over 8,000 volumes, the collection of 120 magazines, the 550 parchments, manuscripts and continuous donations make the library a truly specialized institution, which requires continuous updating and is equipped with modern IT tools.

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LOZZO Out of the ordinary places

Lozzocan rightly be defined as "The land of mills": the Rio Rin, a stream that flows alongside the town, has always represented its vital hub. Its driving force has allowed the development of numerous productive activities: along the path of the Roggia dei Mulini, several factories once used as mills, forges and sawmills are still visible. The objects and photos collected in the Dairy Museum, set up in the spaces of the former social dairy, active between 1884 and 1984, allow the knowledge of the traditional procedure for the processing of cheese, butter and ricotta to be passed on. Along the streets and walks of the town, instead, the panels are installed which together constitute the Widespread Ladin Museum: the main rural activities of the Ladin culture are described there. In addition to the historical and cultural offerings, Lozzo presents some elements of great naturalistic value, such asthe Tita Poa

Oxenit is an area of enormous naturalistic and landscape value, which represents the limit of the Fastern Marmarole. It can be reached from the town of Lozzo via the Strada del Genio (during the summer season it can also be travelled by car in alternating one-way traffic). Roads and paths for access on foot also start from the Valley of Rin and Monte **Agudo**. The plateau is made up of large flat meadow areas, hills and grassy valleys, still used for grazing today. Hikers, cyclists, snowshoe hikers and off-piste skiers can enjoy a unique spectacle from Pian dei Buoi: the panorama includes the Three Peaks of Lavaredo, the Dolomites of Auronzo and Comelico, the Carnic Chain, the Dolomites of Oltrepiave, the Spalti di Toro, the Antelaoand many other Dolomite peaks, as well as the valleys below. Numerous artefacts dating back to the First World War are also visible on the plateau, the most important of which are the fortifications of Col Vidal and the related





and complementary works, which form an integral part of the system, such as trenches, caves, anti-aircraft positions, gun emplacements and bunkers.

The Street of the Millspresents evidence of a past in which water was used as a driving force in the processing of wheat, wool, iron and wood. The hydraulic power factories present along the Rio Rin are one of the best examples of industrial archaeology in Cadore and the recent reconstruction of the wooden irrigation ditch and the wheel of one of the mills allows us to better understand the historical value of the place and admire its beauty. Today, along the irrigation ditch, you can see the ancient canalization and three mills, one of which is fully functional, in addition to the buildings once used as sawmills and forges. The route of the Roggia del Mulini also includes an interesting visit to the electrical power plant"Baldwin Carulli". active since the early 1900s: up until the 1990s it supplied electricity to a good part of the ancient village of Lozzo, while today it serves around 200 users.

TITA POA BOTANICAL TRAIL

The Tita Poa Botanical TrailIt is an itinerary of about a kilometer and a half created in 1991 by the CAI of Lozzo: it skirts the town to the north, at an altitude between 800 and 930 meters. It takes its name from an inhabitant of Lozzo who until the venerable age of 105 loved walking in these woods.

The course aims to promote knowledge



scenography of the typical vegetation of this natural environment and develops along paths that have always existed. The vegetation present is spontaneous and the only human interventions are those aimed at its maintenance and the identification of the various species through the affixing of a tag.

DAIRY MUSEUMS

AND OF THE WIDESPREAD LADIN

The Social Dairy of Lozzo di Cadore was founded in 1884 and remained in business until 1984. Today, in the spaces of the former social dairy, a museum is offered to visitors to spread knowledge of the traditional procedure for the processing of cheese, butter and ricotta. A series of 16 thematic panels that tell the stories of the customs and traditions of the town of Lozzo di Cadore constitute the so-called **Widespread Ladin Museum**.

They are installed in the villages and along the most popular walks, to give the visitor the opportunity to familiarize themselves with some aspects of the rural activities of the Ladin tradition. The open-air museum, of great educational and cultural value, aims to guide the visitor to the discovery of the typical rural aspects of Lozzo that significantly recall the past of the mountain communities.

SKI on the DOLOMITES

The Auronzo/Misurina ski area is divided into two main locations: the Auronzo area, with 20 km of slopes, on Monte Agudo, and the Misurina area, where you can ski on Col De Varda with the spectacular scenery of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo in the background. The two areas are part of the Dolomiti Superski.

The ski slopes www.monteagudo of Mount Agudo - Auronzo

ALBERTO TOMBA TRACK.It is a red slope that runs through the woods, 2,714 m long, at an altitude of 1,528 and with a gradient of 27%. It has several bends and technically quite challenging sections, especially in the upper part where there are continuous changes in gradient. Downstream, you can also arrive directly from the black Fedo slope. To travel it in its entirety, you need to take the four-seater chairlift that starts near the center of the town of Auronzo. It is one of the most beautiful slopes in the area, the fastest and the most

long: you won't get bored even if you do it several times, due to the variations that appear along the way. Highly recommended for skiing enthusiasts in the Dolomites.

MALON TRACK.It is a red slope 860 m long, at an altitude of 1,530 m, with a gradient of 22%. Along the route you can enjoy a breathtaking view, especially by stopping at the refuge right in the middle of the slope (highly recommended for the food and hospitality). It is served by the Taiarezze-Malon chairlift, the main facility of the area, a modern four-seater that, in just 15 minutes, takes you from Taiarezze to the refuge on Monte Agudo.

FOLLINA TRACK. Another red run, 780 m long and 1,340 m high, with a gradient of 16%. As you can tell from its gradient, it is among the easiest red runs, certainly the most accessible after the Ansiei training camp. It offers wide curves that cut diagonally across the steep slope until it enters, further downstream, after having crossed it several times during the route, the very long Alberto Tomba.

FEDO TRACK.Black slope 720 m long, at 1,528, with a gradient of 42%. It is u that descends straight from the summit of Mont do. View from the Taiarezze-Ma chairlift an impressive aspect, as the gradient is even more evident.

TAIAREZZE TRACK.This is a 863 m long track, at an altitude of 1.10 with a 30% gradient. It is the second three tracks that descends from Monte Agudo towards Pomauria: it follows a sort of path starting from Alberto Tomba and then goes back towards the Ansiei ski school. The two tracks are easy and suitable for families.

POMAURIA TRACK.Red slope of only 252 m, at an altitude of 1,573 m, with a gradient of 17%. It is the first section of the slopes that from Monte Agudo

SHOVEL TRACK.It is a 2000 m long black slope, very technical, the only one in Misurina; it was used in 1964 during the Innsbruck Olympics as a training ground. It can be reached via the recent Col De Varda chairlift and, at the end of the descent, it joins the red Mazzorana slope. Preferred by the most expert, it is defined as one of the most beautiful slopes in the area.

VARDA TRACK.It is a 2800 m long red slope of medium difficulty. It starts from the highest point of the Misurina area, Col de Varda, and ends in the parking area at the foot of Lake Misurina; after a wide initial curve, it tends to descend downwards with an almost straight line.

MAZZORANA TRACK.It extends inside the forest at 1,853 m and lower than Misurina. It is a red slope 2800 m long and is, in parts, of medium or difficult difficulty.

SASS TRACK.Red trail considered a variant of the Mazzorana, as it runs approximately halfway along the route of the latter and then ends in the same point, in the parking area.

LOITA TRACK.More correctly called a training field, it is easily accessible by car. Its length is 750 m and it is the only blue slope in the area: suitable for the first approaches to skiing in the Dolomites.

DO YOU PREFER CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING?
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DOLOMITES the 4 routes more beautiful with the snowshoes



In this article you will find useful information on some of the most beautiful trails in the Dolomites to walk with snowshoes on your feet in an area perfect for this sport: the Auronzo and Misurina area. The mountains in winter are not just skiing and among the most beautiful activities to do are certainly snowshoes that allow you to walk on the soft blanket between the snowy paths. Discovering spectacular corners and views in the heart of the mountain crossing woods far from the chaos is nothing short of regenerating.

Here is the list of the 4 most beautiful routes to do with snowshoes on your feet.

1 • AURONZO REFUGE

There is a unique and special place, a place so beautiful that it attracts so many people every year, I'm talking about the Tre Cime di Lavaredo. If you want to see them covered in snow, one of the best places is the Auronzo refuge. The first itinerary I propose is precisely the snowshoe hike that will take you in front of the Tre Cime in a succession of

beautiful sensations given by the views that will alternate and that will undoubtedly amaze you. The route is easy and uphill, the road is beaten but I recommend that you first inquire about the snow and ground conditions at tel. 0435 39002. The travel time is about 2.5 hours while the difference in altitude is 500 m. From Lake Antorno you need to follow the road that will take you to Malga Rinbianco, from there the path begins to climb. You will be presented with a series of hairpin bends that on the slopes of Pian Logeres will take you to the refuge. There are no words that can express the beauty of this area, not by chance it is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

2 • CARPI CITY REFUGE This itinerary is recommended for the views it offers between the peaks of Marmarole, Sorapis and Cristallo. The route is almost entirely on the southern slopes of the mountain, therefore sunny, provided that the sky is not covered by clouds. The route is easy but with a difference in altitude of 750 m while the travel time is about 2 hours. From the Col De Varda square the path begins to climb until it reaches a fork: on the left you reach Col del Varda while on the right you continue towards the Città di Carpi refuge. If you do not feel like climbing, it is possible to reach the Col de Varda refuge with the chairlift, then go down to the fork, skirting the ski slope and continuing towards the Città di Carpi refuge. From Col de Varda the path continues slightly downhill to the destination.

3 • A. BOSI MOUNTAIN PIANA REFUGE

This itinerary, in addition to offering unforgettable views, has a high historical value. Mount Piana was the scene of important historical moments related to the Great War where the Italians faced the Austrians in incredibly prohibitive environmental conditions. The mountain is called this way precisely because it has a fairly flat summit comparable to a

panettone, while the slopes are steep and characterized by ravines, cliffs and valleys. Climbing Monte Piana with snowshoes is not only a historical revisitation but the conquest of a mountain with spectacular views. During the winter season it is also possible to reach Monte Piana by snowmobile and then return by sled (if you prefer). The route lasts 2 hours one way and the difference in altitude is 400 meters. The itinerary starts from Misurina, precisely from the Loita ski slope. Climb to the middle of the slope and turn left following the signs for the Bosi refuge. The trail is CAI 122.

4 • MARAIA HUT

This trail is quite easy and will take you to Maga Maraia where I recommend you stop for a typical lunch of great taste. The route is about 2 hours and the total difference in altitude is about 300 meters. The itinerary starts from the parking lot of the Cristallo hotel along the SR48 that from Auronzo leads to the Tre Croci pass. From here, after parking the car, follow the path until you reach the mountain hut.



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Discover the Beauty, Stay Aware

Hiking in the mountains in winter is a wonderful experience, but it requires extra attention and preparation to ensure safety and respect for the environment. It is essential to be aware of what you are doing and respect the beauty of the environment around you.

Here are some helpful pointers:

1Preparation and planning:get informed about the weather conditions and snow and ice conditions. Check the forecast and if possible, ask for advice from experts or Local Alpine Guides. Choose a route suited to your level of experience and the current conditions. Always let someone know your itinerary, departure time and expected return time.

2Equipment:wear warm clothing,

layers, and waterproof. Remember that temperatures can be very low and the wind cold. Winter hiking shoes with good grip and gaiters to protect from snow. Use crampons or microspikes if the path is icy. Bring adjustable poles, preferably with a snow hook. Don't forget a hat, gloves, scarf or balaclava and sunscreen to protect from the sun and glare on the snow.

3Behavior on the trail:walk with caution

tion, avoiding slipping or endangering yourself and others. Respect the signs and indications and follow the beaten or marked paths. Leave no traces and take away all waste. Respect nature and wild animals, avoiding disturbing or damaging the environment.

4Safety:carefully evaluate the conditions of the ice and the snow: if they are too dangerous, it is better to give up or change route. Do not tackle descents or passages that are too difficult without adequate experience or equipment. Bring a first aid kit, a head torch





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

THE'**JULY 11**The third edition will be inaugurated by a legendary figure of British and world mountaineering, Mick Fowler, who has won the prestigious Piolets d'Or award several times and has made numerous extremely difficult first ascents in virtually unexplored areas.

The **JULY 18** it will be the turn of a figure who is now very well known on social media, in the press and on television, Marika Ciaccia, alias My Life in Trek, a reference figure among young and old for walks, excursions, long treks in the mountains and more.

The**JULY 25**a great mountain narrator will be a guest, Stefano Ardito, probably the greatest Italian representative of journalism dedicated to the mountains and

to hiking author of countless books on history, current affairs, hiking guides, and in addition to this, of documentaries for TV and docufilms.

The AUGUST 1 Igor Koller, the greatest Slovakian climber of all time, will be in Auronzo. He has become a legend for a route he opened in 1981 with his climbing partner Jindro Sustr on the south face of the Marmolada, the Via Attraverso il Pesce. He will dedicate the evening to his fifty years of love with the Marmolada.

THE'AUGUST 8the well-known mountaineer, journalist and writer from Turin Enrico Camanni, who will present his latest editorial work in Auronzo, a thriller with a new case set in the mountains. From fiction to reality the step will be short and Camanni will go from



literature to current events to tell in literary form his love for the mountains and mountaineering.


